LOCATION

Imbabala Zambezi Safari Lodge is situated on a riverine fringe of the mighty Zambezi River where Zimbabwe, Botswana, Zambia and Namibia converge. Located 80 kilometers west of Victoria Falls, access is by transfer from Victoria Falls, Livingstone or Kasane. Imbabala offers the chance to unwind but also some of the most amazing game viewing and bird watching in the region, in the seclusion of a private National Parks concession.

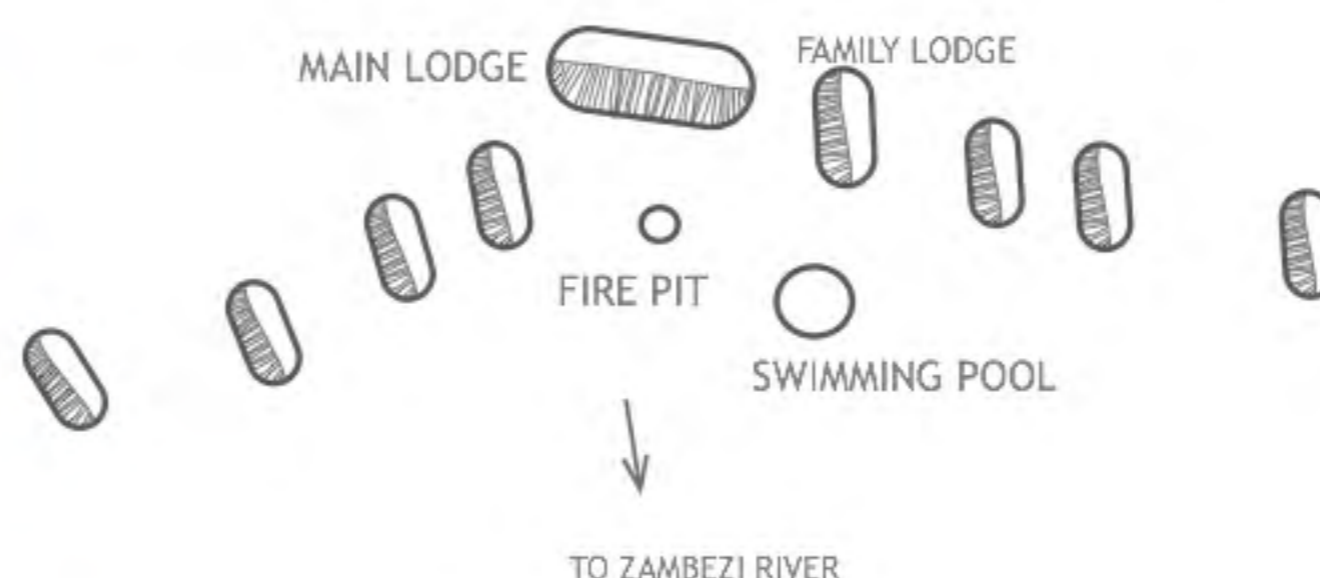
The 5,000 acre concession has 14 kilometers of private Zambezi river frontage and borders the Chobe Forest Reserve, which is renowned for its massive elephant population.

ACCOMMODATION

Imbabala Zambezi Safari Lodge offers exclusive accommodation for only 20 guests in 9 individual thatch lodges with en-suite facilities. Each lodge is uniquely decorated and beautifully positioned with spacious verandas opening onto sweeping views of the Zambezi River. Imbabala has one family lodge, (Sleeps 4), four double and three twin-bedded lodges. All doubles can be converted to twins on request and vice versa.

FACTS & FACILITIES

- The main Lodge is a charming thatched structure, consisting of a lounge, dining room and bar area. This offers fantastic views of both the river and a nearby waterhole, which attracts game throughout the year
- A swimming pool and al fresco eating area nestle under classic riverine trees.
- Mouth-watering meals are served either outside under the stars or in the open-fronted dining room.
- There are no fences to prevent animal movement, so expect to see game and wonderful birdlife along the river bank as well as in and around the Lodge.
- Your stay at Imbabala Zambezi Safari Lodge is inclusive of accommodation, three meals, drinks on all activities, scheduled land and water game-viewing activities, and laundry.
- Local brand drinks are included in your stay at Imbabala Zambezi Safari Lodge. Please note that Premium Brand drinks will be for your own account.
- Transfers, drinks, gratuities, curios and all items of a personal nature are not included.
- Children over the age of 7 are most welcome at Imbabala. Children under the age of 7 on request only. Children should be under supervision of their parents or a guardian at all times. Children aged 7-12 years will be charged 50% of the adults sharing rate.
- 220 Volt mains electricity is available.
- Due to its remote location, credit cards are not accepted at Imbabala Zambezi Safari Lodge.

GAME DRIVES

Guests can choose a daily morning, afternoon or night drive to get their fill of the wonderful game viewing that is available here. All drives are conducted in open-backed 4x4 vehicles that are suited to the terrain and are perfect to afford the best views of the game. Guests will enjoy either morning tea, coffee & snacks or evening drinks & snacks depending on which drive they are on.

RIVER SAFARIS

Up to 12 guests can enjoy the River Safari on the lodges pontoon boat which is equipped with 2 x 25HP motor(s). Drinks and snacks are provided and your guide reveals some of the Zambezi's natural beauty as you cruise the river, often being treated to the sight of wildlife at the water's edge and water-loving birdlife. This is a popular activity and also often provides incredible African Zambezi sunset photo opportunities.

WALKING SAFARIS

Guests have the chance to experience a walking safari at Imbabala. Your professional guide will show you some of the large and small wildlife of our private concession area, highlighting species that might get missed if on a drive. The chance to get up close and personal with the larger species is also very exciting and who can ever forget their first elephant encounter while walking.

ZAMBEZI FISHING

Imbabala offers excellent angling for the legendary tigerfish, which is rated as one of the best fighting fresh water fish in the world, a reputation it fully deserves. The majority of tigers caught range between 2 - 6 lb. but each season specimens of between 10 and 18 lb. are landed. Most anglers focus their attention on the tigerfish, however it is not uncommon to catch some of the other species. Below are the major sport fish species found at Imbabala.
